DISPOSITION: Arrested by Shelburne Police & to be arraigned at Chittenden District Court later today

On July 16, 2010 at approximately 12:30 am Burlington Police were flagged down by a person reporting that about 40 minutes prior they were assaulted and robbed at gunpoint in a parking lot near the corner of Main Street and St. Paul Street by two men. It was reported that during the robbery multiple gunshots were discharged.

Fifteen minutes later another report of an assault and robbery in which gunshots were fired was received from a victim at the intersection of South Winooski Ave and Adams Street.

All victims in the events in Burlington were male and all received minor injuries during the assaults.

A short time after that the Shelburne Police Department received a report that a taxicab had been robbed at gunpoint in Shelburne. The driver was uninjured.

Investigation and a police canine track led Shelburne officers to a house in Shelburne where two suspects that matched the description provided by all victims were located. Both were taken into custody without incident. Some property from the robberies was recovered.

Investigation is ongoing and in the early stages at this time. More information will be released as it is available.

Charges are expected to be filed today, including at a minimum, multiple counts of Assault & Robbery with a weapon.
