On July 20, 2010 members of the Burlington Police Department responded to a report of an Attempted Armed Robbery that occurred at the Simon's Store located at 42 Park St. in Burlington, VT. A lone suspect entered the store and demanded that the employee open the register. The suspect brandished a black handgun, while ordering the employee to open the register. The suspect fled the scene on foot before any money was surrendered. The employee gave the following description of the suspect:

A white male, 20 to 25 years-old, approximately 6', medium build, wearing a dark gray zip-up hooded sweatshirt and dark rimmed sunglasses. The suspect appeared to be clean shaven or with a slight "5 o'clock shadow."
