During the early morning hours of Tuesday, July 6, 2010, at approximately 0230 hours (a.m.), Burlington Police responded to an apartment on South Winooski Avenue, for a reported Burglary. Investigation revealed that four unknown males entered the apartment and accosted a 26 year-old Burlington resident, before leaving the residence with an undisclosed amount of currency. As a result of the incident, the male victim received non-life threatening injuries. The male victim was treated at the Emergency Room of Fletcher Allen Health Care in Burlington and released a short time later. Investigation has revealed that this is not a random incident.

The four suspects fled the location on foot and were described as being white males, wearing dark clothing, hooded jackets and bandanas covering their faces. This investigation is ongoing and the police are asking that anyone with information to contact Detective Paul Petralia at the Burlington Police Department at 540-2147 or Crime Stoppers at 864-6666. **The Burlington Police Department is offering a substantial cash reward for any information leading to the arrest of those involved.**
